Explore comparative education and international teaching!

Experienced teachers (at least one year) enroll in a CC graduate course (4 semester hrs, beginning in spring 2017) and engage in comparative educational studies on campus with an individualized focus on a selected country. Participants continue by teaching abroad from June 5—30, 2017, in P-12 school placements. Upon return, participants reflect and report on their experience and how it might transform their own classroom. The CC experienced teacher scholarship (50% off tuition) applies to this summer course.
