There is one action that reduces transmission of COVID-19 by 80%.

Wearing a mask.



The Coronavirus is highly contagious through respiratory droplets that are transmitted from the mouth when someone is talking, yelling, or singing and is in close proximity to others. You could breathe in these droplets, or touch a contaminated surface and then touch your face near your nose or mouth.

If you have COVID-19 (even if you are unaware that you do), wearing a mask helps prevent you from transmitting Coronavirus to others. If someone else has COVID-19, their wearing a mask prevents them from transmitting the virus to you. The risk further decreases when you follow additional safety protocols.

You are in control of your own decisions.

That's why it's so important to wear a mask, wash your hands frequently, and avoid large crowds. Limit your social circle to your roommates, your household, or just a few friends who practice healthy behaviors and good hygiene.
