

**Women's Concerns Committee:** encourages the development of a campus climate hospitable to women by supporting equal opportunity policy, monitoring the hiring and review practices of the college, and advocating support groups for women. Time commitment is 4-5 hours per block. (2 students)

**Financial Aid Appeals Committee:** discusses financial aid appeal cases, and recommends possible recourse. (2 students)

**Athletic Board:** recommends policy for intercollegiate athletics, club sports, and intramural sports. This committee also advises the administration on athletic budgets, schedules, personnel and facilities. Time commitment is about 1 hour per block (2 students)

**Committee on Curriculum:** brings student opinions to the CC curriculum. It assesses all aspects of the CC curriculum, including graduation requirements, writing programs, courses, classes, enrollment figures, etc. It also assesses the academic program and recommends improvements, considers issues referred to by the Faculty Executive Committee, and reviews new programs. Committee meets once a block for 2.5-3 hours (3 students)

**Dean's Advisory Committee:** interprets academic rules and regulations, reviews venture grant proposals, reviews leaves of absences, and approves applications for liberal arts and science majors. Students are voting members in the approval of venture grants. Time commitment is about 6 hours per block. This is usually about 2-3 hours reading venture grants before the meeting, and about 2 more hours discussing them at the meeting. (2 students)

**FYE Committee:** reviews the First Year Experience program and suggests methods to improve it. Professors communicate with students to reflect on student need and opinion. Time commitment is 2-3 hours per block. (2 students)

**Student Conduct Committee:** adjudicates cases of non-academic conduct violations and presents its finding and recommendations to the Dean of Students and the VP of Student Life. The committee utilizes an "innocent until proven guilty" philosophy. Committee holds special appeal to pre-law students. Time commitment varies greatly, but could be 4.5-6 hours per block. (8 students)

**Information and Technology Board:** makes policy recommendations regarding the use of information technology in teaching and learning at the college. (2 students)

**Minority Concerns Committee:** promotes cultural diversity by developing new policies and monitoring compliance with the college's equal opportunity policy, encourages a hospitable campus climate, and monitors hiring and review practices at the college. (2 students)

**Campus Sustainability Council:** evaluates ways to make Colorado College more sustainable, by developing new environmental programs, supporting campus environmental initiatives, and awarding grants to sustainable initiatives. The council works with faculty, students, staff, trustees, alumni, and community members to implement concrete improvements in sustainability on this campus. (2 students)

**Budget Committee:** evaluates and assesses the Colorado College operating budget. Offers input and suggestions regarding the allocation of campus funding and financial resources. Time commitment is about 3-4 hours per block. (2 students)

**Committee on Instruction:** focuses on approving courses, course descriptions and credits. Time commitment is about 2-3 hours per block. (2 students)
