Committee Updates

Finance – Student Activity Fee will be the main focus for the next three blocks. The Finance Committee is entertaining the idea of a referendum from the student body for the purpose of the student activity fee. They will be meeting with Bethany Grubbs this week. There will be an e-mail going out the first week of 4th block to appeal for funds. Decisions will be made during 3rd week. Steven will send all new club information to Ariel. That way, they can apply for funds for next block. Finance Committee may move some of the reserve money into operating budget funds instead of special events funding. There are 10-15 new groups. Ariel also had a meeting with Glenn Winkle, an employee looking to start up a CC speed skating group. He has requested money for rink pads. Moving forward, a CC student will have to come forward and get the team recognized as a club. CCSGA will revoke the operating budget for the CC Nordic team for next year. If a group is recognized as a club sport, they should not receive an operating budget.

Internal Affairs – The committee will continue to market the exec positions over Thanksgiving break. Exec elections and informational sessions will be held during Block 4. Interest has already been shown in the position. The internal review will be up shortly, and the CCSGA Parliamentarian will oversee the results. Committee updates for the block need to be sent to Annika by the Sunday before 4th week. She will then write a cohesive document that will be sent out to the campus by Internal Affairs.

Student Life – Steven is nearly done with the election programming. The election night party will be tomorrow night. PSAC has been contacted, and hopefully they will be able to help set up. Steven also has a budget committee update. Robert Moore does not like to divide odd numbers, so the student activity fee will be raised to \$16 instead of \$15. A vote is needed from Full Council for this to take place, and will be put on the agenda for this Thursday. Student Life Committee has continued to meet with the administration. They have met with Lynette and discovered there is not much that we can do about the room reservation process. There is a tutorial on the room reservation website page that should be added to the Finance tutorial that is held at the beginning of every year. Also, NASU has returned the money that was unaccounted for after their trip to Standing Rock. A slide about fundraising should also be included in the Finance tutorial. Advisor accountability has been a large concern lately for all groups. There is no oversight over how prepared the advisors actually are, as most advisors see it as a perfunctory thing to do. The Finance Committee suggested that there should be training for advisors of groups with budgets. This should include budget management and goal setting. If the advisors do not come to the meeting, the group will not receive funding. Steven will

send out a survey asking student groups what they want to see coming from their advisor. Ethan has followed up on the room commitments for exclusive membership status, and they are working on getting their rooms booked for the rest of the year.

Outreach – Andrew has written a proposal for how they will keep all-college committees accountable. Andrew has created a Google check in sheet. Annika wants mandatory, blockly reports, as it is her job to know what is happening in these committee meetings. A dinner to gather the All-College committee student members will happen this year in order to foster a more inclusive environment, and make them feel as if they are a part of CCSGA. Andrew is meeting with Scott Godde this week. Scott is a CC student who is interning at the City Council Office. Andrew is also looking into a mentorship program. The Butler Center has infrastructure for the mentorship program. Once the program is started, the Meaningful Inclusion Committee can overtake this assignment.

Meeting with Breanna Conwell - Steven had a meeting with Breanna in regards to the documentary on safe spaces. We will hire a film major to spearhead the project. The edited testimony will be made into a documentary. The unedited footage will be uploaded to the website in its entirety. The logistics are beginning to come together. A venue will be determined for the screening once it is produced. We want a variety of students represented – maybe a more intimate venue.

Board of Trustees Meeting – It went very well. They appreciated our approach in supporting students on campus.

Bylaws – They will be e-mailed out to Full Council members by this Thursday.

Meetings with Co-Chairs of Butler Center Groups – Annika has been setting up meetings with co-chairs of Butler Center groups. This is in order to create a relationship with these groups. She will keep us posted on their status.

Plan of Action – Meetings are being coordinated for a plan of action in relation to sexual assault. More information will come in the near future.
