

1 **COLORADO COLLEGE STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION**

2 **An Amendment to Eliminate Mention of CCSGA Review of Student Organization Budgets**

3
4 Preamble: WHEREAS The Colorado College Student Government Association has not voted on
5 whether to approve the Finance Committee’s budget allocations to student organizations in
6 recent memory,

7
8 & WHEREAS The Colorado College Student Government Association Finance Committee has
9 communicated that they allocate budgets to over 100 student groups,

10
11 & WHEREAS The Colorado College Student Government Association Finance Committee has
12 further communicated their belief that CCSGA review of these budgets would be both time
13 consuming and difficult to organize given their budget allocation schedule,

14
15 & WHEREAS The Colorado College Student Government Association Constitution currently
16 states in Article VI, Section 6.07, subsection e, clauses 3 & 4 that “After the budget decision-
17 process is complete, the Student Finance Committee must make its recommendations to the
18 CCSGA. The CCSGA will then vote whether or not to approve the recommended budgets. (See
19 ARTICLE VII. Certification of Student Organizations)”,

21 SECTION I: Article VI, Section 6.07, subsection e, clauses 3 & 4 of the Colorado College
22 Student Government Association Constitution SHALL BE STRUCK VIA AMENDMENT.
23 Section 6.07, Subsection e shall now read:

25 e. During Block 7 of each year, the Student Finance Committee must go through a process
26 of deciding the following year’s budgets for Chartered and Recognized student organizations.
27 The Financial Vice President and the committee members are responsible for determining the
28 requirements for this process. (see Article VII. CERTIFICATION OF STUDENT
29 ORGANIZATIONS)

31 SECTION II: This legislation shall go into effect after passing CCSGA Full Council using
32 proper amendment procedure and after being approved by the President of Colorado College.
