

1 **COLORADO COLLEGE STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION**
2 **An Amendment to Transfer Authority over CCSGA Communications with Student**
3 **Groups to the Student Life Committee**
4

5 Preamble: WHEREAS The Colorado College Student Government Association Student Life and
6 Internal Affairs Committees have both communicated the view that the Student Life Committee
7 should oversee the student group Chartership and Recognition processes,
8

9 & WHEREAS The Colorado College Student Government Association Student Life
10 Committee’s duties concern the student experience at Colorado College,
11

12 & WHEREAS these and other responsibilities of the Student Life Committee have made the
13 Committee the primary body which interacts with student groups concerning matters relating to
14 their internal governance and compliance with CCSGA Recognition and Chartership guidelines,
15

16 & WHEREAS The Colorado College Student Government Association Constitution still
17 formally vests much of this responsibility with the Internal Affairs Committee and Vice-
18 President of Internal Affairs,
19

20 & WHEREAS Sections 4.10, subsection d, 7.02, subsection h, and 7.18, subsection d all
21 prescribe the primary point of contact for student groups in these matters as the Internal Affairs
22 Committee and Vice President of Internal Affairs,

24 SECTION I: Section 7.02, subsection h, and Section 7.18, subsection d of the Colorado College
25 Student Government Association Constitution SHALL BE AMENDED TO REPLACE all
26 mentions of “Internal Affairs” with “Student Life”. The relevant portions shall read as follows:

28 Section 7.02 In order to receive Recognition Status, a group must meet the following
29 requirements:
30

31 h. It must not enter into agreements or contractual arrangements which use the college’s
32 name or insignia or make official reference to the college, its students, or campus
33 organizations without first obtaining written authorization from the Vice President of Student
34 Life.

36 Section 7.18 Public Performance Groups (PPGs)

38 d. The group must submit a written Policy of Exclusion to the Student Life Committee
39 which clearly delineates who will be excluded from the group and explains in what ways
40 those excluded individuals prevent the group from accomplishing its performance-driven
41 goals. The Student Life Committee will then decide whether or not to recommend this
42 group for a special designation.
43

44 SECTION II: Section 4.10, subsection d of the Colorado College Student Government
45 Association Constitution shall be AMENDED TO TRANSFER the text of subsection d to

46 Section 4.08 subsection d, and all subsequent subsections in Section 4.10 shall be re-lettered
47 accordingly. The relevant portion of Section 4.08 shall read as follows:

49 Section 4.08 The Vice President of Student Life has the responsibility to do the following:

51 d. Maintain communication with all certified organizations.

53 SECTION III: This legislation shall go into effect after passing CCSGA Full Council using
54 proper amendment procedure and after being approved by the President of Colorado College.
