President:

- Make CCSGA more transparent and more representative of all students.
- Develop better community between all groups on campus, such as Greek Life and the Butler Center.

Outreach:

- CC Night on the Town – continue annual event providing discounts for CC students at local businesses.
- Help Promote Porch Fest, the Old North End block party.
- Meet with organizations around Colorado Springs, such as UCCS.

Student Life:

- CC recently designated JED Campus, and has therefore established a JED Committee on campus. Student Life has appointed Junior Representative Skelly to serve on this Committee in hopes of improving mental health services on campus.
- Maintain relationships with Second Floor Worner administrators, such as the office of the SARC and the Butler Center.
- Provost Focus Group – Vice-President Greenberg is serving on the Provost Search Committee, and invites CCSGA Reps to participate. The Provost will be the chief academic officer once selected.
- Student recognition and chartership process – Student Life seeks to make the process flexible yet rule-based.

Internal Affairs:

- Work with the Inclusion Committee – help foster communication with campus.
- Wants to make meeting minutes more well-known on the CCSGA website.
- Work on CCSGA bulletin board, Vice-President Torres says he'll update board regularly.
- Fill vacancies in student government – currently CCSGA has 4 unfilled positions: 3 Heads of State Representatives and 1 Senior Representative.

Finance:

- Make sure Finance portion of CCSGA website is up-to-date, reflecting current policies on fundraising and special events funding.
- Maintain transparency in funding decisions.
- Foster closer relations with Campus Activities' Events Summit.

- Work with the Inclusion Committee.
- Preemptive meetings with organizers of large events that were controversial last year to assist them in rectifying issues with their events.
- Student Group Budget Workshop at 12:00 pm on September 5th.

Inclusion:

- Vice-President Fasshaieake history and heritage months more visible at CC.
- Meet with heads of historically-marginalized groups to bolster inclusivity on campus.
- Sponsor two dialogues a semester generating suggestions to make events, and campus as a whole, more inclusive.
- Work on defining equity.
