Inclusion Committee Bill Discussion

This is not replacing the current Heads of State position(s), but rather, works in addition to that. In this position, you must be in a Butler Center group to run for this position, but it is a vote open to all campus. The point has been made that groups can be removed by the Butler Center. CSA is not a member of the Butler Center. Steven believes that the framework of the Butler Center is ideal for this situation because it would be nearly impossible to create a framework independent of them. Where will the money come from to pay them? It will come from the Administrative Fund. There is no problem on the behalf of the Administrative Fund, and Rochelle has already approved this for the Admin Fund. Is there any way that CSA can apply for the position? CSA is not affiliated with ASU. Steven wants to create a special designation for groups that are added to the Butler Center for this specific position – an informal member of the group. Who decides who gets to use the CC Butler Center's name – Dr. Buckley. By not having an Inclusion committee, it forces all of us to probe inclusion. By adding an Inclusion Committee to CCSGA, Abe is concerned that it will take away the spirit of inclusion from CCSGA. Rather, they would just be deferring to another committee. Who gets to define inclusion? Abe views this as defining the other. His third concern is that he does not think CCSGA does not want to expand their numbers. Annika believes do not have enough people to do the work that needs to be done. This committee's function is to carry out the things that are planned. We have done a lot, but we could do so much more if we delegated these tasks to a committee. Annika does not believe it would distract from the spirit, and it would be helpful to have those numbers. Ariel thinks that we need more people in CCSGA since there is so much work to be done. This extra committee will help alleviate the amount of work that needs to be done. Every committee will retain a direct links to the Heads of State via that position. This will allow us to project in a way that is more thoughtful and directive. We are lacking the perspective to effectively audit our practices. Steven, in conversation with Dr. Buckley, has identified that Heritage months are lacking coordination and planning. This committee could help plan events for these months. This committee can help those groups coordinate resources, and help us to institutionally support these events. We can say that we value diversity, but this institution enshrines that mentality in the DNA of CCSGA. Abe says the time to speak may not be to speak in a large group setting, so it is super important to make sure that there are avenues of dialogue and discussion with people on executive council. We must ensure that we build in moments for dialogue with small groups.
