### **Committee Updates**

*Student Life Committee* – CC Votes is currently in the process of collecting ballots. Ballot collection is currently taking place in the basement of Worner Center. They are currently planning the end of the election party for Nov. 8<sup>th</sup>. Steven plans on reaching out to the Political Science department and other departments for wall-to-wall coverage on the night of the election. The Student Life Committee met with Heather today to discuss areas of student interest. Steven's committee will be starting a new initiative to address students/administrative concerns for booking the various venues on campus.

*Internal Affairs* – Aaron is currently working on getting a newsletter out. This newsletter will bring attention to what CCSGA is doing, tips and tricks, services, etc. The Internal Affairs Committee is currently putting information on the bulletin board. They are also in the process of organizing an informal event to get to know new members. An informal retreat will be held next Saturday. This retreat will include a dinner and a fun (non-mandatory) activity. Exec elections are coming up; information will be coming out second week of this block. Elections for Internal Affairs and Student Life will be held at the end of this semester.

*Outreach* – The next dialogue dinner will be a lunch/discussion with Dana Wolfe. The lunch will be held from 12:15-2:00 pm. The discussion will be centered upon power and gender dynamics. Andrew will also be meeting with the President of CU-Boulder's student government tomorrow. They will talk about initiatives that both CU and CC can work on.

*Finance* – This week, the Finance Committee has funded a dinner for the Brazilian Club, the Food Rescue for Moon Hooch, ORC Fall Fest, SOMOS, and the Ponderosa Project. Ariel also announced that a vote will take place at this meeting on the Student Activity Fee

**Announcements** – STEM has been granted exclusive membership status.

**Student Activity Fee** – The Finance Committee has proposed to raise the Student Activity Fee \$15 for the next academic year. Although this is not a binding list, they have proposed the following as an allocation for the raise:

\$3 for club sports – This will help to pay for travel costs and jerseys

\$6 for arts and crafts – This will eliminate the cost of materials, making classes free

\$6 for Llamapalooza – This will pay for a headliner for the event

The motion has been approved in a vote of 15-1. CCSGA will recommend to the Budget Committee that the Student Activity Fee should be raised by \$15 for the following academic year.
