

November 2nd Full Council Meeting Minutes

Agenda:

1. BSU Finance Presentation:

BSU presented finance presentation to CC for upcoming event over \$5000. Seeking to sponsor writer Percival Everett for an appearance at CC to discuss his writing on the Black identity in academic spaces.

Itinerary:

- Sunday, December 3rd-Tuesday, December 5th
- Monday, December 4th – Class observation, lunch with Advanced Fiction class, 5:30 reading in Bemis Great Hall, Meet & Greet in Glass House, Dinner with English Department.

Total Cost: \$6,863.22

- Seeking to engage USAFA and UCCS students as well
- BSU expects student turnout of 60-70 in total.

2. Finance Presentation:

- Average Special Events Fund-utilizing event is \$967
- \$65,361 remaining in the SEF budget – this event would represent approximately 10% of remaining budget
- Max honorarium grant in the past 2 years was \$5000
- Question about lack of Cultural Attraction Funding
- Concerns about delay in attending Student Event Summit – BSU had not yet attended Student Event Summit as is required by Finance Committee guidelines.

Recommends \$5,663.22
