

## October 5 Full Council Meeting Minutes

### **Agenda:**

#### **1) Student Voices Series: Rail Jam**

FUCC presented about the history of Rail Jam during this first presentation of the Student Voices series concerning the event. A copy of the presentation to be included with these minutes is pending.

### **President:**

- Talking to Career Center about improving the Senior Transitions Series.
- Continuing to talk to Jill regarding bringing Professor Roberto Gonzalez to CC to discuss DACA.
- Drafting letter to student body concerning DACA renewal effort.

### **Student Life:**

- Met with SARC and will be meeting with Title IX Coordinator regarding federal changes to Title IX.
- Ditch Disposables – Advertising campaign to reduce use of disposable items in Bon Appetit facilities.
- Bon Appetit contract up for renewal, Student Life keeping tabs on administration's position on this matter.
- Vice-President Greenberg Meeting with Campus Activities in the coming week.

### **Internal Affairs:**

- First year elections are October 6th, Election Committee will be meeting that evening at 7:00 pm to certify the results.
- Executive Council positions up for election next block: Vice-Presidents of Student Life, Internal Affairs, and Outreach.

### **Finance:**

- Vice-President Filion working with FUCC on Rail Jam Student Voices series.
- Still seeking advisor authorization from for roughly 50-60% of student groups.
- Student group budget appeals have ended.
- Not funding Dance Workshop costume pieces this year to account for reduced funding for student events.
- CCSGA has spent roughly \$14,000 on special events thus far, in line with typical CCSGA expenditures at this point in the year.

### **Inclusion:**

- Hispanic/LatinX Heritage Month has concluded, LGBTQIA+ History Month runs through October.
- First Inclusion Committee dialogue went well.
- *Get Out* Screening Tuesday, October 10<sup>th</sup>, first in series of conversations regarding Charlottesville.

- Interested in creating social justice training for CCSGA, but apparently the group that performs the training is booked up for two years in advance.
  - President Djalilzadeh questions whether we could have social justice training for faculty, due to reports of untoward comments heard by President.
