#### 1. CCSGA Committee Updates

##### **President:**

- Proposed exploring the legal ramifications of making CC a sanctuary campus.
- Full Council will have dinner with Dean Edmonds on September 13<sup>th</sup> at 6:00 pm.

##### **Outreach:**

##### **Internal Affairs:**
