 - Opening support
 - Finance committee has poor representation for traditionally marginalized groups
 - Finance committee is important and independent in CCSGA
 - Diversity adds tangible benefits to ability to job
 - Making sure representing what cc actually looks like
 - Opening opposition
 - Yes, lack of gender/racial diversity this year
 - But better to get more people to run
 - Building policy around this not necessary in this way
 - Cuts out ability for non-heads of state to run
 - Takes up quarter of finance committee
