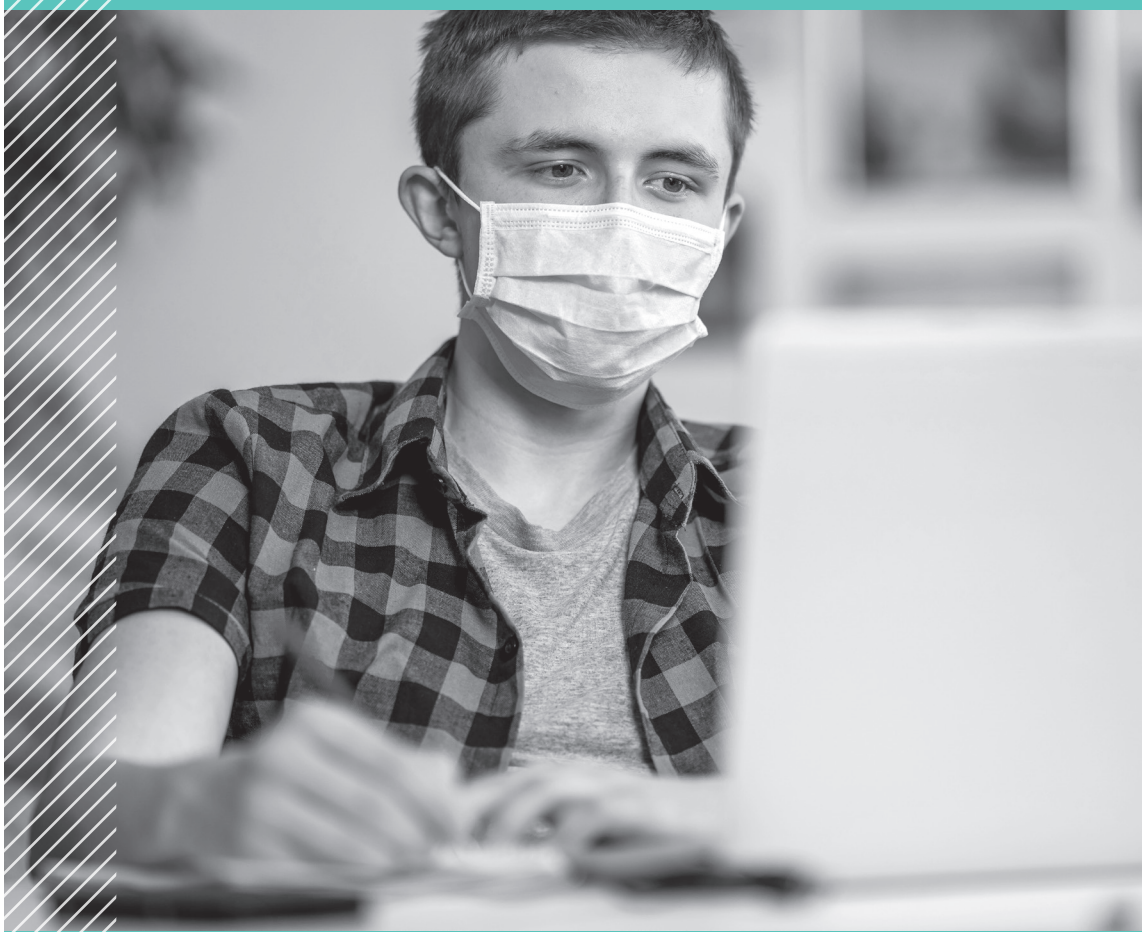


FACT
