STOP & READ



All students will be tested upon arrival to Colorado College.

Once you have been tested, you must follow **enhanced social distancing protocols**. You must:

- Remain in your room and avoid all social interactions
- Leave your room only to pick up food available on campus, or to exercise on your own outdoors
- Follow these protocols until you receive your COVID test results

If you test positive, you will:

- Go into isolation for at least 10 days
- If at the 10-day mark your symptoms have resolved, you could be cleared to leave isolation
- If you still have symptoms, you will stay in isolation until the symptoms have cleared and you've been released by the public health department or by a medical provider
- Participate in contact tracing to identify those you may have been in close contact with before your positive test result

If you test negative, you must continue to follow **regular safety protocols** at all times while at Colorado College, including:

- Wearing a mask over your mouth and nose in all public indoor and outdoor spaces
- Maintaining a distance of six feet from others at all times
- Washing your hands frequently and for 20 seconds
- · Avoiding gatherings of more than 10 people; preferably hang out with those with whom you are living
- Covering your coughs and sneezes and avoiding touching your face
- Cleaning surfaces you come in contact with often, like your cell phone
- Staying home and avoiding others when you feel sick
